

## **Standard management for children with diabetes during surgery - Summary Clinical Guideline Derby & Burton**

### Summary guideline

This guideline is intended for use in the management of children and young people up to 18 years of age with diabetes mellitus undergoing surgery under the care of the Paediatricians in Derby and Burton. It is important to avoid the immediate complications of diabetes peri-operatively, particularly hypoglycaemia and ketoacidosis.

There should be close liaison between the surgeon, the anaesthetist and the paediatric diabetes team. Where possible, the paediatric diabetes team will write a personalised guideline depending on the current treatment for the child or young person and the nature of the surgery planned. This will be based on the full guideline.

If there is not a personalized guideline available, the ward team should follow advice for emergency surgery.

Elective surgery should be postponed if the child/ young person has an HBA1c >75mmol/mol
